What we will be learning..

ELA: The students will describe the structure of a story, including describing how the beginning introduces the story and the ending concludes the action. They will describe how characters in a story respond to major events and challenges.

Math: The students are learning about 2D and 3D shapes. They will be able to identify and draw a shape based on its attributes. They will recognize that a trapezoid is a quadrilateral with exactly one pair of parallel sides



Science: The students are continuing to learn about the three states of matter. They will be able to classify objects and describe how material can move from one phase to another due to change in temperature.



Did You Know?

It is important to listen to your child read.

When your child starts bringing books home from school, have her read to you. If it doesn't sound good (mistakes, choppy reading), have her read it again. Or read it to her, and then have her try to read it herself. Studies show that this kind of repeated oral reading makes students better readers, even when it is done at home.
