"Hoo-Ray" For Learning

Language Arts - Asking and answering questions during and after reading (characters, setting, events?); Comparing and contrasting pieces of information from the text. Phonemic Awareness - telling all the sounds heard in a word (beginning, middle, and ending).

Writing - Informative/expository writing. Telling facts and how to's. Remember basic sentence structure and to always end a sentence with punctuation.

Science - Observing, recording and explaining certain weather patterns.

Social Studies - Discuss and explain ways to be a good citizen and why it is important.

Math - Rote counting 0-50, counting objects 0-20, using two numbers to make ten, and representing addition and subtraction using counters, pictures, drawings, words, and equations.
