"Hoo-Ray" for Learning

English Language Arts - Asking and answering questions about key details during and after a book (characters, settings, events, retelling) to help check for understanding; Critiquing books as we make sure illustrations and the message match; Using reading strategies to figure out unknown words; Making connections within the text.

Math - Recognizing and writing numbers 0-20 fluently, understanding the relationship between numbers and quantities as we count sets 0-20, composing and decomposing numbers, rote counting 1-50 by ones and tens, recognizing and describing measurable attributes of 3D shapes (cone, cube, cylinder, and sphere).

Social Studies - Tell and explain the roles of a citizen and why it is important for citizens to obey rules in the classroom, school, home, and neighborhood.

Science - Observing the positions and motions of objects and organisms in an environment.
