## “Hoo-Ray” for Learning!

**English Language Arts** - Continue to read nightly together at home. Discuss the parts of the book and ask comprehension questions about the story. Participate in a discussion about what was read. What was your favorite part? Who was your favorite character? Why?

**Writing** - Composing opinion writing and giving 3 reasons for your opinion. Composing narrative writing that includes characters, settings, a beginning, a middle, and an end. Remember basic sentence structure (capitalization, spaces, b/m/e inventive spelling, and punctuation).

**Math** - Counting to 100 by ones and tens, composing and decomposing numbers 1-10, comparing quantities, comparing shapes, describing measurable attributes.

**Science** - Forces and Motions - describing the way things move and how they move. Reviewing physical properties and different kinds of materials from which objects are made and how they are used and the basic needs of living things.

**Social Studies** - Understanding the roles of a citizen and learn about various jobs around their town of New Bern.
